CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

AIC 2008 is showcasing research on nutraceutical approaches to improving animal health and productivity. Abstracts are welcomed. Please submit your 250-word abstract in English only. All abstract submissions will be acknowledged electronically, and presenting authors will be notified of their acceptance. Individuals submitting abstracts which are selected for presentation will be asked to submit an extended abstract (~2 pages) to go into the proceedings book. All presenting authors will be required to be registered for the meeting. The deadline for abstract submissions is September 1, 2008. English will be the official language of the Congress.

- Nutraceuticals to improve productivity and health of livestock
- Animal health management in organic livestock production
- Natural product solutions for pest management, manure management, protection of water quality and other important agricultural issues
- Probiotics and prebiotics and their effect on animal health, nutrient digestibility and/or energy partitioning in livestock
